Funding and support



The Doctoral College holds two types of research funding.

Postgraduate Research Fund (PGRF)

£2,500 for funded research trips, including conferences. This can only be applied for once in your studies and in a competitive fund.

Please take some annual leave. It is important for your wellbeing!


To take annual leave: email your supervisor, with the time and date you'd like to take as leave. Your supervisor needs to email to approve the leave you're taking.
