Unlock the Power of IT in 7 Steps

1. Set up your Password

Your username will look like this: ab12345@gmul.ac.uk

When you start at Queen Mary you will receive an email with your temporary password.

Please change this password as soon as possible and don't let other people use it, no matter how good a reason they give you.

2. Set up Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) adds an extra layer of security when accessing online services. You may already use this for online banking or your personal email account.

When you create or reset your password, you will be able to choose how to set up your authentication.

We recommend you use the Microsoft Authenticator app as your authenticator method.

3. Download the Queen Mary 'QMUL' App

Download the Queen Mary 'QMUL' App which has many handy features in one place, including campus maps, attendance recording, library resources and IT service updates.

Download the app on the App Store for Apple or Play Store for Android, by searching 'QMUL'.

4. Access your Queen Mary email account

All students receive a Queen Mary email address during their time here. Our email service is provided by Microsoft 365.

Official communications are sent to your Queen Mary account, so it is important you check it regularly.

 You can download Office Suite on 5 devices!

5. Access MySIS/SITS (your student record)

MySIS is where you see your enrolment information, registered modules, financial information, personal details and provisional results amongst other things.

After enrolment, use your Queen Mary account (not your application account) to access MySIS.

It is important to keep your personal information up to date on your record.

6. Log into QMplus (online learning environment)

QMplus is your online learning environment.

On QMplus you can access your timetable, module information, assignments and more.

7. Set up Wi-Fi - eduroam

eduroam is Queen Mary's Wi-Fi service.
