The Chair said that Governance Committee would keep this under review and re- examine the process if this occurred. Council approved the proposed amendments to Ordinance A4. The University Secretary said that arrangements would be put in place accordingly to fill the existing vacancy for an academic staff member on Council.		Elections to fill two staff vacancies – one academic staff member (all faculties) and the non-academic staff member – are in progress. The nomination period closed July 3 rd . The ballot will take place 17- 31 July. Candidates will be invited to have ar informal conversation with a current member o Council about the role before the ballot launches.
