Aims and Objectives

This presentation approaches the complex field of endodontics with a broad overview. The ten questions set up in the presentation provide problematic talking points for the speaker to amplify. Given the loss of interaction provided by Zoom it is obviously impossible to obtain any feedback at the time of the presentation, which would normally prompt discussion and debate. If the delegates wished to peruse their interest in these endodontic topics, hopefully this lecture might provide that framework for them.

Learning Outcomes
