

MA in Anglo-German Cultural Relations

RATIONALE

You will have a unique opportunity to work with practitioners from the media, publishing and cultural organisations and discover the theoretical, critical and methodological complexities of Anglo-German cultural transfer.

You will also deepen your awareness of the development and significance of Anglo-German cultural relations, analysing both history and current practice.

General Points

- Only degree course of its kind in the UK

- Links to German cultural institutions, such as the Goethe Institute, the DAAD and the German Embassy
- Work placements with a media, publishing or cultural organisation, subject to availability

Structure

- One compulsory Core Course (2 semesters)
