

QMUL CONFUCIUS INSTITUTES 'CHINA OPPORTUNITY' SUMMER CAMP 2025





Requirements

Students must complete a 20hr Chinese Mandarin course (plus 20hrs self study) followed by a HSK assessment which will be provided for by the QMUL Confucius Institute as part of the programme (dates tbc).

Students can use websites such as BBC to study Mandarin on their own.

Registration Deadline: 20th March 2025-6.00pm.

A non- refundable deposit of £375 to be paid by 20th March 2025.

Summer camp details

QMUL Confucius Institute will be running a summer camp from 29th **June-12th July 2025** together with Beijing University od Post and Telecommunications.

Students will spend two weeks in Beijing. You will learn about the China of today; attend cultural performances, such as Chinese opera and acrobatics; go on excursions, such as visiting the Great Wall of China; study Chinese language; participate in Chinese cultural activities, such as Tai Chi and many many more.

Accommodation and meals will be provided for.



Programme details

 performances; guest speakers;

 classes; pre-departure HSK exam
 preparation classes in London. **You only need to pay** for the return
 flights from London; travel
 insurance & visa (price subject to
 change depending on flights costs).
- Cost does not include: Return flights to China, personal spending money; transport to and from London Heathrow.
- Please note: the schedule is very full and students are unlikely to have free time for personal visits.
- Please note: We will need students passports for up to one week in order to apply for a visa (if you want us to apply for the visa for you).
 Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from time of flying.

Summer Camp will allow you to discover the China of today: economy, culture, language, and history. It will increase your knowledge of the country and the opportunities China can give you.
